Sub: Staging of 58th West Bengal State Shooting Championship (WBSSC) 2026 in Small Bore & Air Rifle and Pistol (NR) events and 58th West Bengal State Shooting Championship (WBSSC) 2026 Air Rifle and Air Pistol (ISSF)

Dear Sir/Madam,

It has been decided to hold the 58th West Bengal State Shooting Championship (WBSSC) 2026 in Small Bore & Air Rifle and Pistol (NR matches) events and 58th West Bengal State Shooting Championship (WBSSC) 2026 in Small Bore & Air Rifle and Pistol (ISSF matches) at Asansol Rifle Club, Paschim Bardhaman, from 3rd August to 9th August 2026.

The championship will be organized by ASANSOL RIFLE CLUB under the auspices of National Rifle Association of India, West Bengal Rifle Association and Bengal Olympic Association as per match details attached.

❖ **General Rules –**

All athletes of currently affiliated valid District Rifle Associations/Clubs/Academies / Institutions/ NRAI Office Units under West Bengal Rifle and Life Members & Donor/ Patron Members of WBRA are eligible to participate in this competition. All athletes must have WBRA registration no.

If any shooter happens to be a member of any Unit/ Club which has become defunct or the shooters of any Unit/ Club which has been suspended by the WBRA for any illegal activities which are derogatory to WBRA or are in contravention of the General Rules framed by WBRA in the interest of our athletes, will be eligible to participate in this competition as a shooter under the banner of WBRA only in individual events. If any shooter of such units wishes to participate in this competition, he / she has to send an email to rtswbra@gmail.com requesting for participation in this competition as an individual participant under WBRA. Such applications must be made before 21st July 2026 clearly mentioning his / her event with mobile no, NRAI and WBRA Shooter id and email address. Decision of WBRA in this regard is final.

Eligible athletes as stated above who want to participate in this competition are requested to go through the following instructions carefully for their own convenience and ensure smooth and successful conduct of the above competition.

1. All the matches will be conducted according to NRAI Match Book. Entry fee for each individual event is Rs 1000/-
2. **Shooter, who has ever participated in NSCC in AIR RIFLE / AIR PISTOL event, are eligible to submit entry in these events only for 58thWBSSC 2026 in Air Rifle and Air Pistol (ISSF matches).**
3. **All ISSF individual matches, Mixed Team matches and Air Rifle NR matches will be conducted in ELECTRONIC SCORING TARGET only.**
4. All entries to be submitted online through www.thenrai.org with **normal entry fees within 26th July, 2026**. Match no for which the shooter is eligible will be displayed in drop list while filling up the online entry form
5. Late entries, if any, will be accepted with **three times the normal fee up to 28th July, 2026. No entry will be accepted after this date.**

Entries through hard copies or through WhatsApp will not be accepted. Entry fees once paid will not be refunded except in the event of the match being cancelled.

6. Entry once submitted cannot be altered or withdrawn
7. Competitor Cards to be downloaded by the participants from www.thenrai.org site by logging in with respective id & password.
8. **Age Criteria & Categories – (As per Rule No 11 of NR Match Book)**
 - I. **Juniors – 21 years (Date of birth 01.01 2005 onwards)**
 - II. **Youth – 19 years (Date of birth 01.01.2007 onwards)**
 - III. **Sub Youth – 16 years (Date of birth 01.01.2010 onwards)**
 - IV. **Masters – 45 to 60 years (Should have completed 45 years one day before Competition)**
 - V. **Senior Masters – 60 to 70 years (Should have completed 60 years one day before Competition)**
 - VI. **Super Masters – 70 years (Should have completed 70 years one day before Competition)**
9. Any shooter if found to be engaged in fraudulent activity or have submitted wrong information will be penalized as per decision of WBRA Disciplinary Committee
10. Shooters taking part in Open Sight events are not allowed to take part in Peep Sight events and vice versa. Shooters taking part in NR AIR PISTOL / AIR RIFLE Matches are not allowed to take part in ISSF AIR PISTOL / AIR RIFLE Matches and vice versa.
11. Shooters taking part in Rifle events are allowed to take part in pistol events and vice versa.
12. Ammunition will be issued to affiliated units for usage of the same by their shooters, against cash payment to WBRA. Unused cartridges and empties of used cartridges must be returned to WBRA.
13. Only three (3) shooters may be allowed to use common weapon. The names of shooters who are likely to use common weapons should be intimated together with the weapon number to rtswbra@gmail.com in advance so as to enable us to work out the relay

allotment for the smooth conduct of the relevant matches.

14. Medals will be awarded as per the following:

- a) Four or more shooters/Team in an Event – 3 Medals
- b) Three shooters/Team in an Event - 2 Medals
- c) Two shooters/Team in an Event - 1 Medal
- d) One shooter/Team in an Event – **NO MEDAL**

Only in the category of Senior Master, Super Master and Para/ Deaf category Medals will be awarded to all the first three shooters.

Medal winning shooters must be present at the Prize Distribution Ceremony. Medal of the absentee medal winning shooter will be forfeited. Medal winners must follow ISSF dress code for the medal ceremony as per ISSF RULE NO-6.20.3.1

15. Team Entry –

A) Team Events will be conducted in all events and Entry Fees for each team is Rs.1500/-.

B) In every match as mentioned in (A) above, entry of maximum two teams will be accepted from each individual club/unit (where the athletes are participating under banner of a club / unit) and maximum four Teams from a District Association (where the athletes are participating under banner of a District Association) . A shooter can be included in only one team of his/her respective unit in a particular match.

C) Entry for team events entry will be accepted only up to 10 am for the matches starting on 3rd August 2026 and for other matches up to 5pm of the previous day of the start of the particular event.

D) Mixed Team

Entry Fees 1500/- per team

Last date for i) Air Rifle Mixed Event is 5 pm on 4th August, 2026

ii) Air Pistol Mixed Event is 5 pm on 7th August, 2026

Each individual club / unit as explained in clause B above, can submit maximum 2 Mixed teams in a particular event and a District Association can submit maximum 3 Mixed teams

16. Matches will start at 08:30 hrs. Shooters will be permitted to shoot only in the relay and lane allotted to them.

17. All Tentative Results will be published on the NOTICE BOARD at the venue. Shooters are permitted to submit protest for any score individually or through team manager within 30 minutes of the publication of that score. Protest fee is Rs.500/-.

West Bengal Rifle Association reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond control and for the interest of the sport and its athletes. Any decision made by the West Bengal Rifle Association in any such matter will be binding and final.

18. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations of the competition. Discipline on and off the field is very essential. Shooting practice in hotels, etc. is strictly prohibited.

19. NRAI shooter's registration and WBRA Shooter registration must be done to submit entry to this competition.

20. Athletes of different Units affiliated under District Association must submit entry under the name of the District Association only.

21. Shooters registered with NRAI under **any state other than West Bengal** are **NOT ELIGIBLE** to participate in this competition.

22. Shooters registered with NRAI under any office institution and posted in West Bengal can participate in this competition in MQS matches only with due permission from his/her office unit.

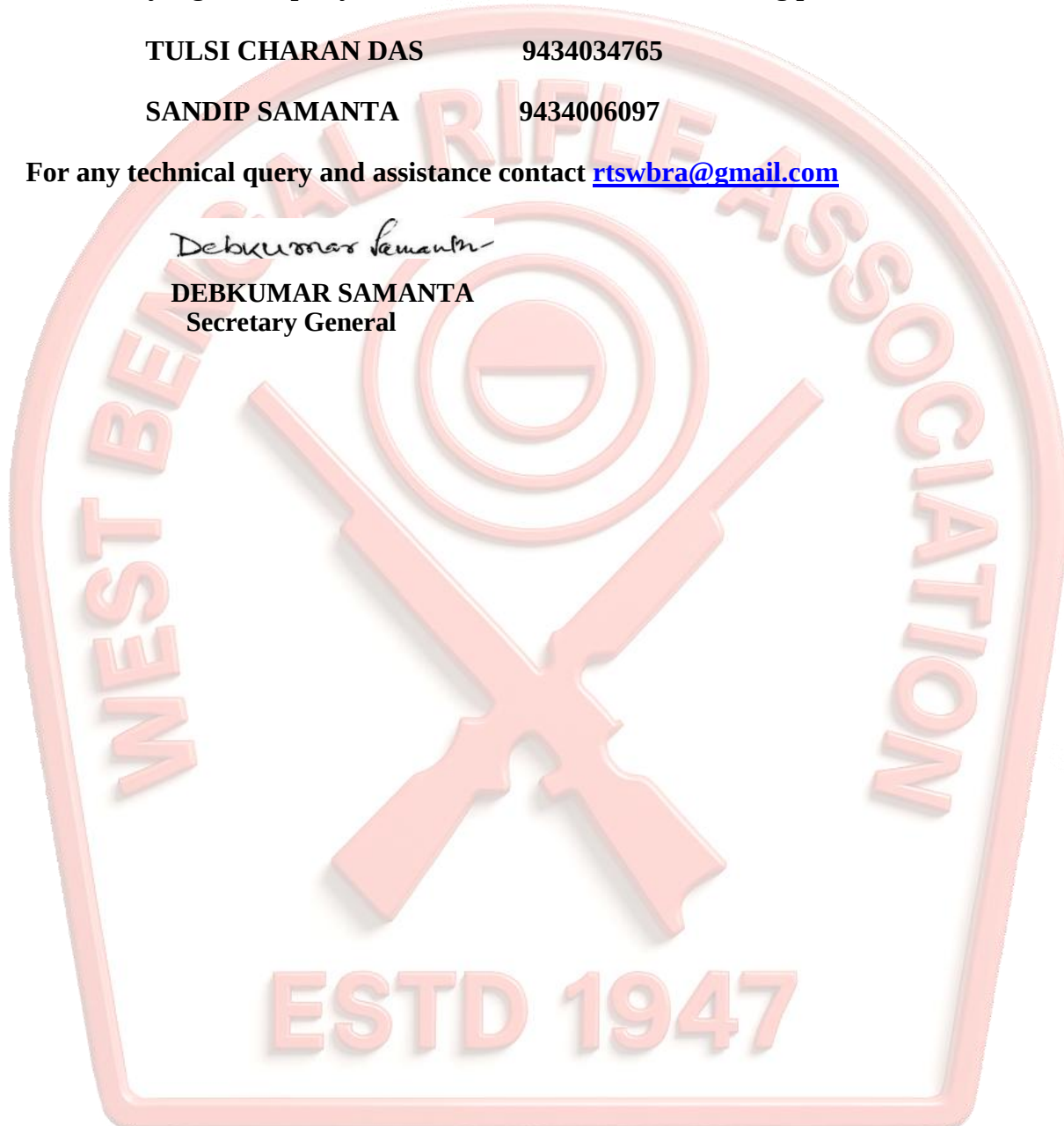
